

**Declaration of Cierra Medina**  
**(pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746)**

I, Cierra Medina, declare the following based on my personal knowledge:

1. I am an adult United States citizen, and I am a resident of Broward county, Florida. I am eligible and registered to vote in Broward county.
2. Before the COVID-19 public health crisis I planned to go in person to my local polling site to cast my ballot for Florida's Presidential Preference Primary Election, which was scheduled for today, March 17, 2020.
3. I did not go vote today because of the COVID-19 public health crisis.
4. I am 30 years old and I am currently pregnant. I also have two toddlers who are currently at home with me because their school has been cancelled.
5. As a pregnant woman I am particularly concerned about the potentially dangerous effects of COVID-19 on myself, my unborn child and my two toddlers.
6. Governor DeSantis has recommended mass gatherings be cancelled. In addition, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommended gatherings of no more than 50 people for eight weeks.
7. Because COVID-19 is a very serious contagious virus and my concerns to myself and family, I am practicing social distancing to protect us. I am presently staying home with my children and I have made arrangements to work from home.
8. I did not vote in Florida's Presidential Preference Primary Election today because, as someone who is concerned about COVID-19's effects on myself, my unborn child and my two small children should I contract it, I could not enter the polling place to cast my ballot and did not have a way to cast my ballot that felt safe.
9. I would have liked to vote.
10. If I could request a vote-by-mail ballot, I would vote in Florida's Presidential Preference Primary Election by returning the ballot through the mail.
11. I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
