We also used oversamples to get key subgroups listed in the bullets below (with the total sample size that includes their natural occurrence in the base sample):


- Working-class African Americans: defined as African American voters with a household income of less than $\$ 75,000$ [n=237; MOE $\pm 6.5 \%$ ]
- Working-class Hispanics: defined as Hispanic or Latino voters with a household income of less than $\$ 75,000$ [ $n=271 ; ~ M O E \pm 6.0 \%]$
- Progressives: defined as people of any race who identify as extremely or somewhat liberal [ $n=585$; MOE $\pm 4.1 \%$ ]
